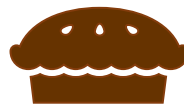

Once upon a time, there was a happy turkey named Bob. One day, Bob was teasing Minnie, the sheep. Then he noticed that few of his feathers were loose.

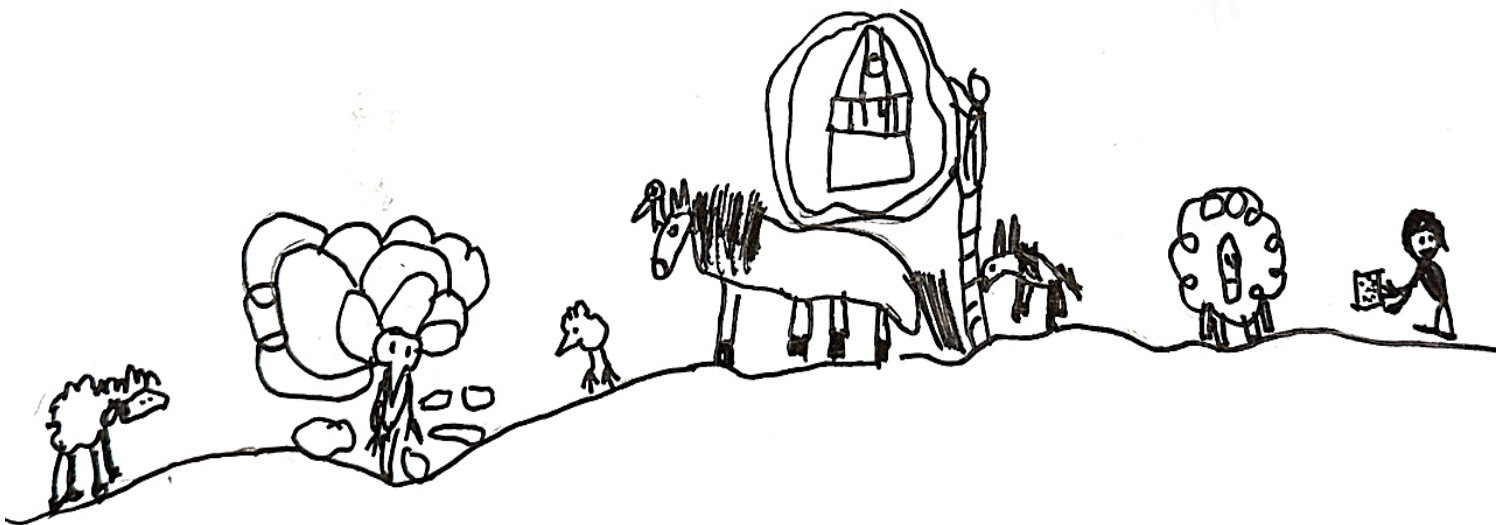
“Oh no!” he cried in despair. “My feathers are falling out!”

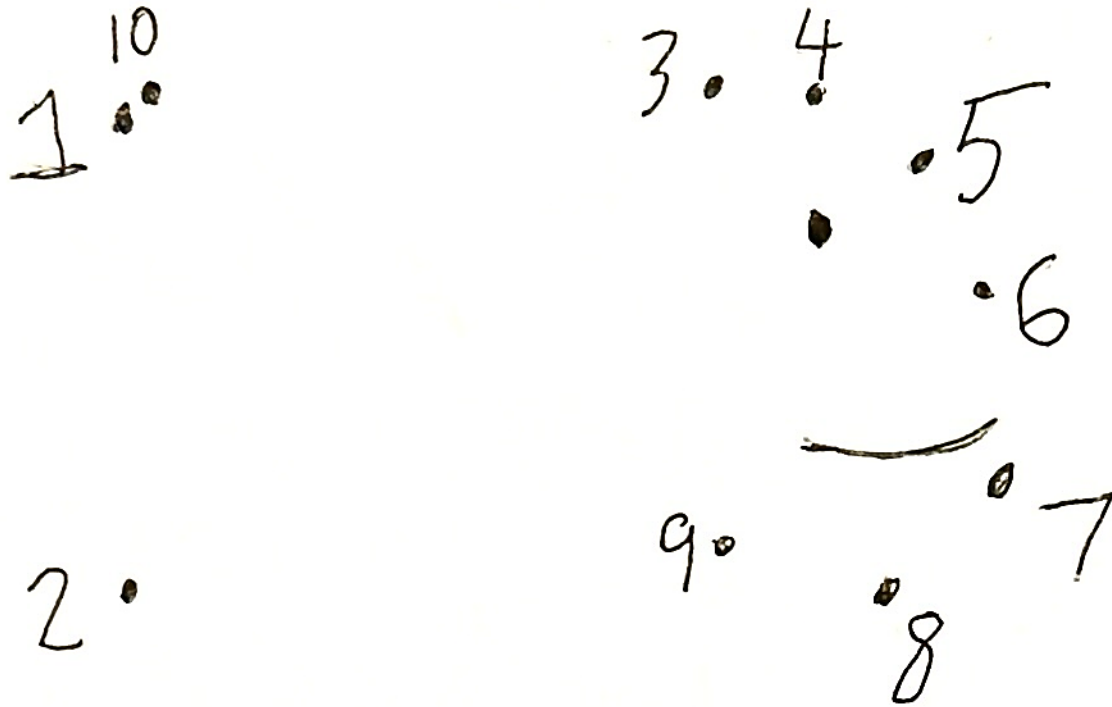

What are you thankful for?



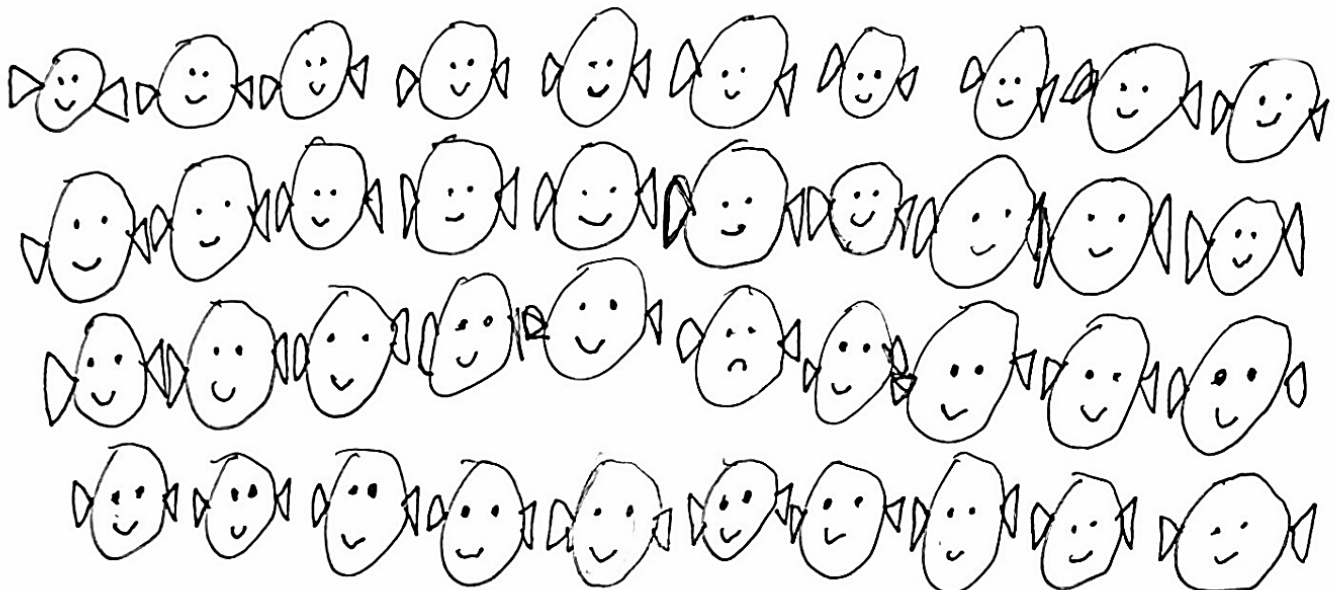

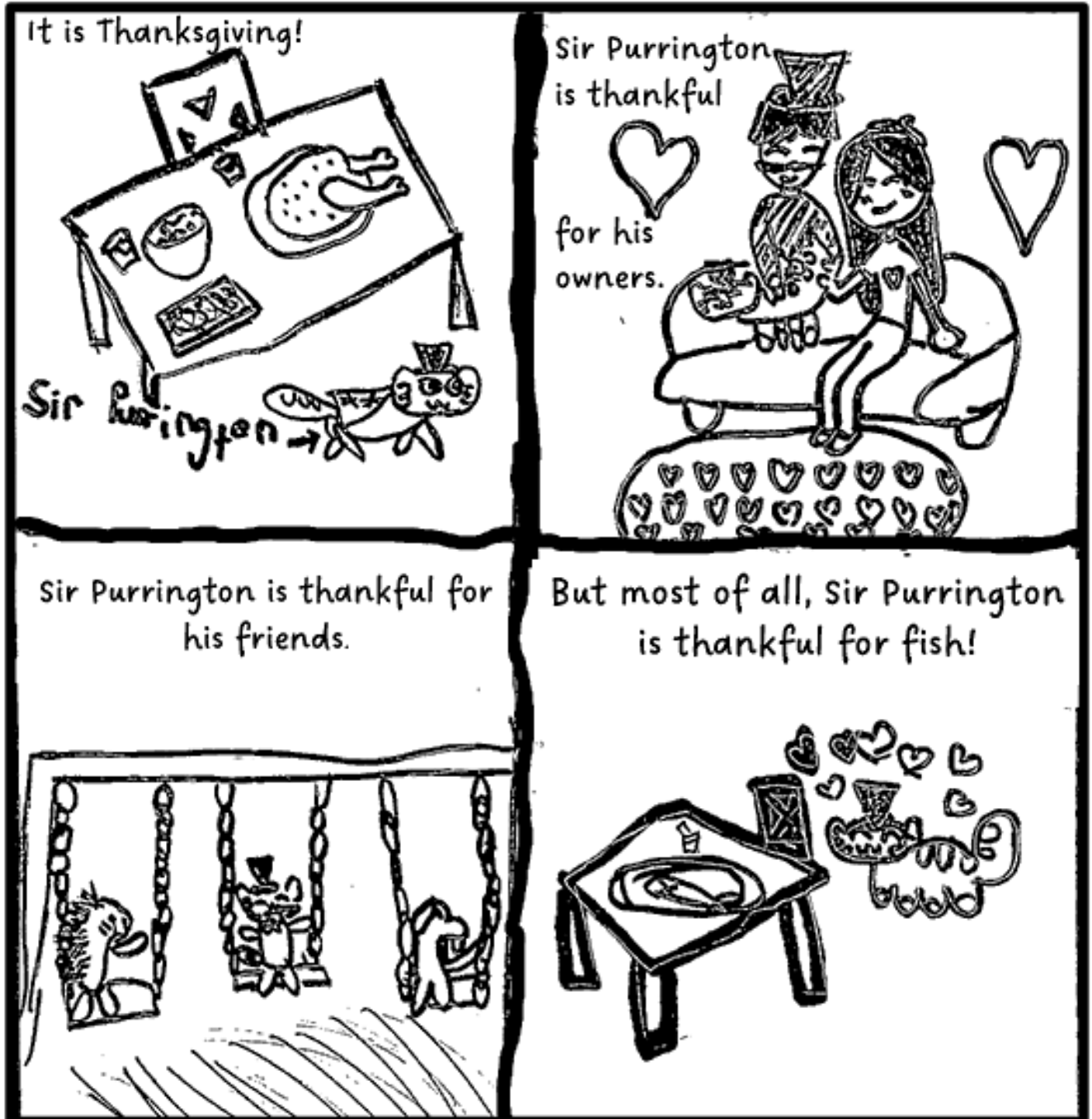

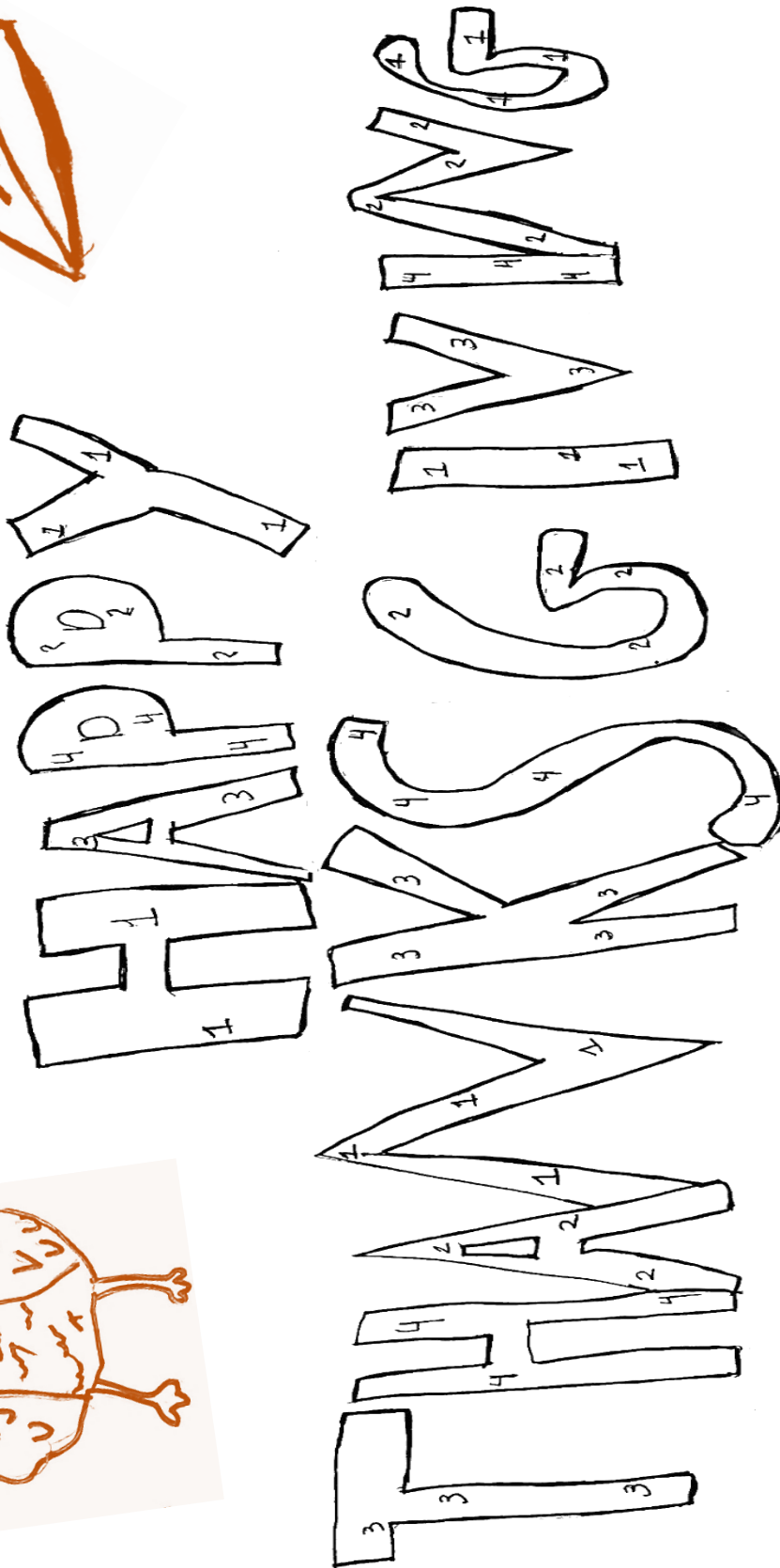

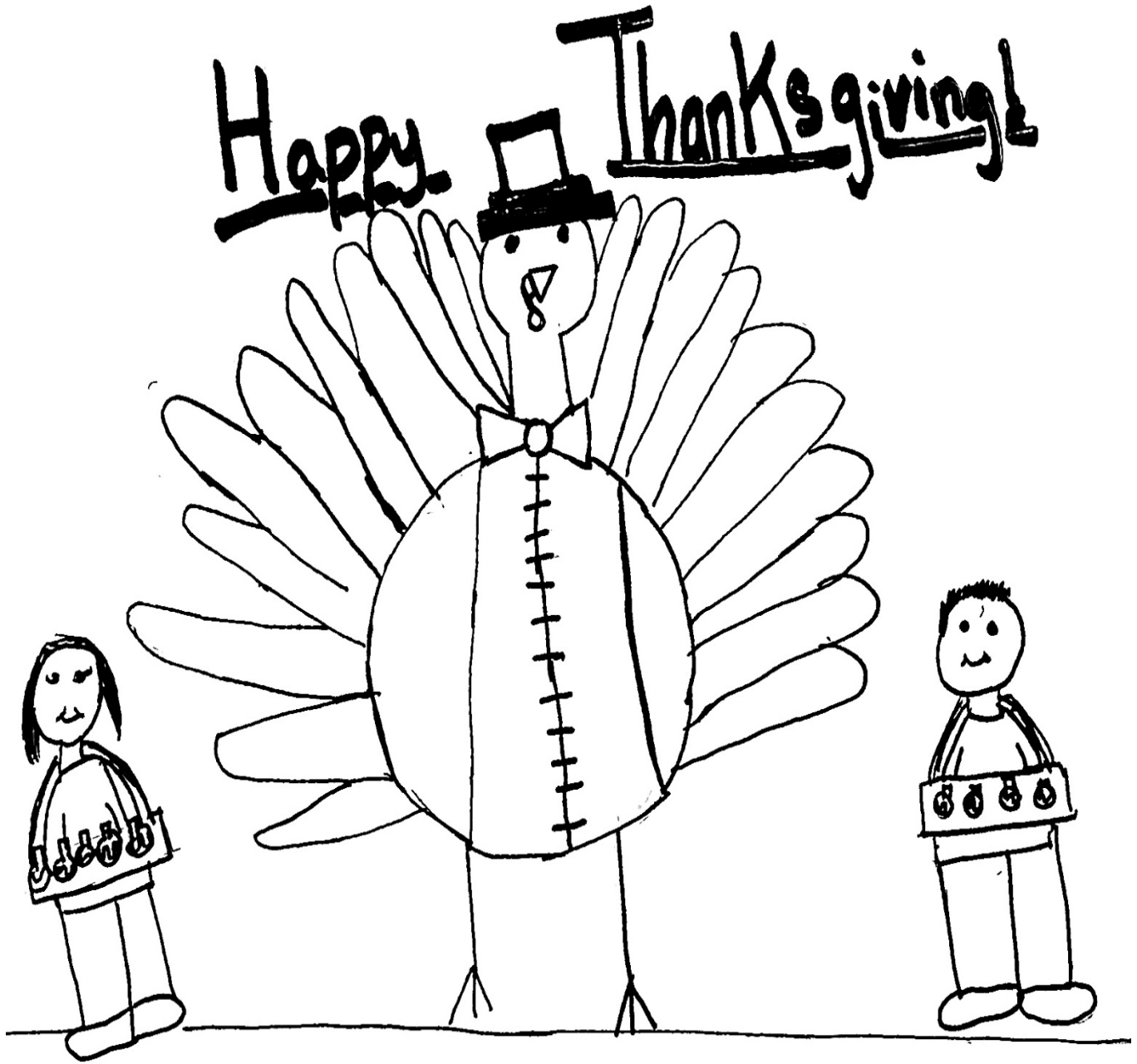
