

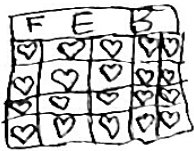

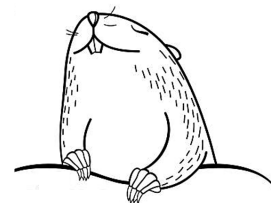
Feeling loved,

The Picnic

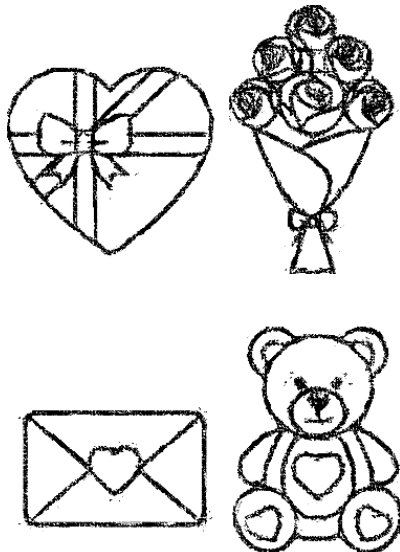
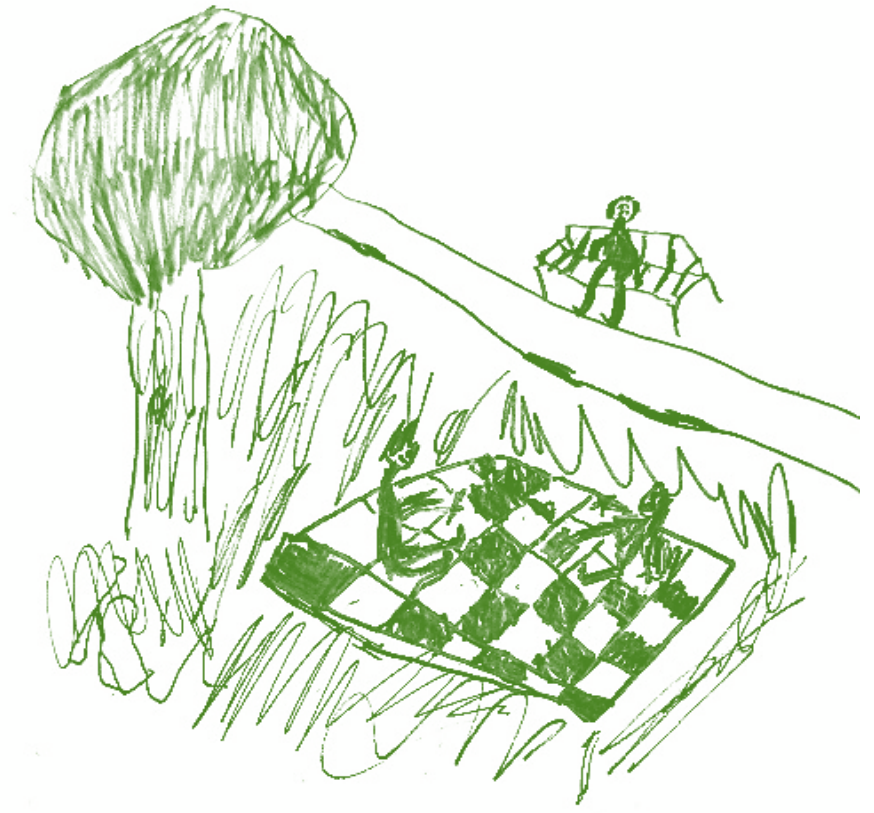
